

PERMITTED USE, WARRANTY AND OTHER TERMS

I. PERMITTED USE

Mopar parts and/or accessories purchased through the Mopar eStore Website are intended solely for use in or installation on the motor vehicles for which such parts or accessories are designed by their manufacturer, in accordance with the instructions and directions of that motor vehicles' owners' and repair manuals.

Should you purchase any part or accessory through the Mopar eStore Website and use it for any other purpose, or misuse such part or accessory in any way, Chrysler disclaims all responsibility, and the entire risk of such use or misuse is yours. Additionally you agree to indemnify Chrysler Group LLC ("Chrysler) and hold it harmless from any liability or damage whatsoever arising out of the use of a part or accessory in such a manner.

II. MOPAR 12 MONTH LIMITED WARRANTY

- a. Mopar parts purchased via the Mopar eStore, or over the counter at an authorized Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep or Ram dealer are warranted against defects in workmanship or materials for 12 months/unlimited mileage for parts (exchange) only unless otherwise noted below. Parts installed on a Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep, or Ram vehicle by an authorized Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep, or Ram dealer are warranted for 12 months/12,000 miles for both parts and labor, or for 12 months/unlimited mileage for parts (exchange) only, whichever is more favorable to the customer.
- b. If the part has been installed on a Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep or Ram vehicle by an authorized Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep or Ram dealer, the Chrysler New Vehicle Limited Warranty covers the cost of towing a vehicle to the nearest authorized Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep, or Ram dealer if the failure of the part causes the vehicle to be inoperative. There is no separate towing coverage for Mopar parts.
- c. If a MOPAR part is installed in Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep or Ram vehicle by an authorized Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep, or Ram dealer, and if, while that part is still under warranty, it causes other parts to be damaged or fail, those other parts will be repaired or replaced under warranty, regardless of whether the other parts were covered by a Chrysler warranty at the time of failure. A MOPAR part used to replace a failed MOPAR part that is still under warranty is covered ONLY for the remainder of the replacement part's existing warranty.

III. MOPAR LIFETIME LIMITED WARRANTY FOR VALUE LINE MUFFLERS, SHOCKS, STRUTS AND TRUCK BEDLINERS.

In addition to the warranty provided above, MOPAR replacement Value Line Mufflers, Value Line Shocks and Struts and Mopar Pickup Truck Bedliners sold and installed by an authorized Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep or Ram dealer are warranted against defects in workmanship or materials for the lifetime of the vehicle on which they are installed. This warranty is given only to the original retail purchaser and is not transferable.

IV. PARTS SOLD “AS-IS” WITHOUT WARRANTY

- a. MOPAR Gaskets and Seals are sold “AS IS” without warranty of any kind.
- b. MOPAR Performance Parts (all parts shown by a MOPAR part number beginning with the letter “P”) are sold “AS IS” without warranty of any kind.

For every part sold “AS IS”, the purchaser assumes the entire risk of loss, damage or breakage. Should the goods prove defective following their purchase, the purchaser and not the manufacturer, distributor, or retailer assumes the entire cost of all necessary servicing or repair.

V. WHAT IS NOT COVERED OR IS RESTRICTED UNDER MOPAR’S LIMITED WARRANTIES

Mopar’s limited warranties do not cover the costs of repairing damage or conditions caused by fire or accident; by abuse, negligence, or misuse (for example, driving over curbs, overloading or racing the vehicle); by improper adjustment, alteration or failure to maintain the vehicle on which they are installed; use of used parts, even if they were originally supplied by Chrysler or Mopar (HOWEVER, the use of authorized Mopar remanufactured parts are covered) or corrosion or damage caused by the use of caustic materials.

Mopar’s limited warranties do not cover any repairs caused by modifications or changes made to your vehicle that are not authorized or approved by Chrysler, except for genuine Mopar accessories installed by an authorized Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep or Ram dealer.

Mopar’s limited warranties do not cover parts installed on a vehicle used for racing or competition, nor do they cover the repair or any damage or conditions caused by racing or competition.

PERMITTED USE, WARRANTY AND OTHER TERMS

Mopar's limited warranties do not cover the costs of repairing or replacing any part due to damage caused by poor or improper maintenance, contaminated fuels, or the use of fuels, oils, lubricants or fluids of a type other than those recommended in your Owner's Manual.

Mopar's limited warranties do not cover the costs of damage caused by environmental factors or Acts of God. "Environmental factors" include such items as airborne fallout, chemicals, tree sap, salt, ocean spray, and road hazards. "Acts of God" include such things as hail, floods, windstorms, lightening, tornadoes, sandstorms, and earthquakes.

Mopar's limited warranties do not apply to any vehicle that has had its odometer or emissions systems tampered with or disconnected (including any unauthorized reflash or modification of any software or firmware designed to control the emissions or operation of the vehicle).

Mopar's limited warranties do not apply to any vehicle that has been declared to be a total loss by any insurance company, or is rebuilt after being declared to be a total loss; or is issued a certificate of title indicating that it is designated as "salvage," "junk," "rebuilt" or words of similar import. Mopar will deny warranty coverage without notice if it finds that a vehicle is ineligible for warranty coverage because it has been salvaged or declared a total loss as set forth in the above paragraph.

Mopar's limited warranties can also be restricted by Chrysler or by Mopar, its Mopar Parts Division, as set forth in the New Vehicle Limited Warranty applicable to the vehicle. If your New Vehicle Limited Warranty is restricted by Chrysler, coverage under your Mopar Parts Limited Warranties will also be restricted or denied.

Mopar's limited warranties do NOT cover any incidental or consequential damages connected with the failure of the part. Such damages include lost time; inconvenience; the loss of the use of your vehicle; the cost of rental cars, gasoline, telephone, travel or lodging; the loss of personal or commercial property; or the loss of revenue. **Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you.**

VI. HOW TO OBTAIN WARRANTY SERVICE

Where both parts and labor are covered by this warranty, repairs will be made by any Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep, or Ram authorized dealer at no charge. While the parts were purchased on-line via the Mopar eStore or over the counter at an authorized Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep or Ram dealer, warranty service is administered through Chrysler, Dodge,

Jeep, and Ram authorized dealers. Where parts (exchange) only are covered, any Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep, or Ram authorized dealer will provide replacement parts at no charge when the part is returned with proof of purchase. It is recommended that you take your Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep, or Ram vehicle to your selling dealer or to the dealer who sold or installed your MOPAR part or accessory. However, you may obtain replacement parts or service under warranty from any authorized Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep, or Ram dealer. Except in an emergency, warranty service for MOPAR parts may be obtained ONLY at an authorized Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep or Ram dealer.

VII. OTHER TERMS

- a. To the extent allowed by law, any implied warranties, including any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, are limited in duration to the duration of these express warranties. To the extent allowed by law, if the parts are installed on a vehicle used primarily for business or commercial purposes, no implied warranties apply. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitations may not apply to you.
- b. These warranties are the only express warranties by Chrysler for MOPAR parts and accessories. Except where prohibited by law, this warranty is the sole and exclusive remedy.
- c. NO person, including a dealer or employee of Chrysler, has the authority to vary or change these warranties.
- d. **These limited warranties give you specific legal right and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.**
